

### Important Child Abuse Guidance Lesson for All Students in February

During the month of February, our school counselors, Juliane Williams (K-2nd grades) and Lori Stuart (PreK, 3rd-5th grades), will deliver classroom lessons about child sexual abuse in classes. These lessons are important because school provides a safe place where children can learn what to do in unfamiliar or uncomfortable situations. Depending on the grade level, students will learn different Protect Yourself Rules' and identify trusted adults who can help them. Notice: Four Seasons Elementary School is equipped with a video camera system. It covers selected interior and exterior public portions of the building and grounds. It is NOT monitored constantly, but it is monitored during emergency situations. During certain events, when the safety or security of students may be in question, authorized personnel from local, state or federal police or fire emergency units may be given access to view images projected on the camera system.
